



HERBERT ASCOTT (BUDDY) LANG, JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Herbert Ascott (Buddy) Lang, Jr. Memorial Scholarship was created by family and friends to honor Buddy Lang, a lifelong resident and active philanthropist in Forsyth County. Buddy was the President and CEO of Lang Signs, Inc., a sign manufacturing facility established in 1929. The initial success of the company was largely attributed to H.A. Lang Sr.'s ability to hand-letter billboards and signs with uncommon precision and skill. Considered a national leader in the sign manufacturing industry, Buddy led Lang Signs through the evolution of technology and digital content with the same level of quality signage produced by his father's brush strokes. He was passionate about continuing education and providing opportunities for others to succeed in an industry he greatly loved.

The Lanier Technical College Foundation will make need-based awards each semester contingent upon a minimum 2.0 per course with an overall 3.0 GPA after the completion of 15 semester hours. Degree must also be completed within 3 years from date of matriculation. This full scholarship is available to Design and Media Production Technology degree students who are residents of Forsyth County. Scholarship proceeds may be used for tuition, textbooks and/or student fees.

The Herbert Ascott (Buddy) Lang, Jr. Memorial Scholarship award will be made upon the recommendation of the Lanier Technical College Foundation Scholarship Committee, based upon their normal review procedure, evaluation of the scholarship criteria, and the applicant's academic standing and financial need. Unique to this scholarship is the potential opportunity for a *paid internship* in graphic design at Lang Signs, Inc. Specific details will be provided to the student selected by the Lanier Technical College Foundation.

Criteria:

The following criteria will be considered in selecting the scholarship recipient:

- Student must be a resident of Forsyth County.
- Student must be enrolled in Design and Media Production Technology degree program at the Forsyth Campus.
- Students must attach a brief statement explaining their passion for graphic design and anticipated career path.
- Student must attach a brief statement explaining the circumstances which necessitate financial assistance.
- Applicants must have a completed FAFSA on file with the Lanier Technical College financial aid office for the year scholarship funding is being requested.

Selection process:

The Lanier Technical College Foundation Scholarship Committee will make the determination of awards. Notification will be mailed to the student's physical address from the Lanier Technical College Foundation Office.

Award Information:

- Scholarship will be limited to \$6,790 for 61 credit hours, and students must be enrolled in a minimum of 2 courses per semester. Scholarship credits toward tuition, fees and books will be issued to the Lanier Technical College Business Office or the Lanier Technical College Bookstore.
